22 Plaintiff MAJOR TEXTILE IMPORTS, INC. alleges as follows:

23 **PARTIES**

24
25 1. MAJOR TEXTILE IMPORTS, INC., (“Plaintiff” and/or “MAJOR
26 TEXTILE”) located at 138 West 38th Street, Los Angeles, California 90037, is a
27 domestic corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of
28 California.

1 2. ALL ACCESS APPAREL, INC. (“Defendant” and/or “ALL
2 ACCESS”) located at 1515 Gage Road, Montebello, California 90640 is a
3 domestic corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of
4 California.

5 3. ALL ACCESS conducts business in the County of Los Angeles, State
6 of California under the name of SELF ESTEEM. A true and correct copy of the
7 Fictitious Name Statement recorded with the County Recorder’s Office of Los
8 Angeles County as Instrument No, 03-1483091 is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and
9 is incorporated herein by this reference.

10 **JURISDICTION AND VENUE**

11 4. This action arises under the Copyright Laws of the United States, as
12 hereinafter more fully appears. Jurisdiction is conferred upon this Court by 28
13 U.S.C. § 1338.

14 5. Venue is proper in the Central District of California in that the subject
15 infringement involves the infringement of a copyright owned by the Plaintiff,
16 which is located in the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State of
17 California, which lies within the Central District of California.

18 6. Personal jurisdiction exists in that ALL ACCESS, whose corporate
19 offices are located in the City of Montebello, State of California, which lies within
20 the Central District of California, derives substantial revenue from the State of
21 California by engaging in a persistent course of conduct in the State of California,
22 and because the subject claim arises from an act within the State of California
23 resulting in injury and damages to the Plaintiff within the State of California.

24 7. In 2006, MAJOR TEXTILE designed a fabric design or pattern
25 known as MA 0606111. Shortly thereafter, MAJOR TEXTILE published said
26 fabric design and/or pattern in the United States.

27 ////

1 8. As of June 28, 2006, MAJOR TEXTILE complied in all respects with
2 the Act of October 19, 1976, Pub. L. 94-553, 90 Stat. 2598, Title 17 U.S.C.A. Sec.
3 101-810, as amended (“Copyright Act”), and all other laws covering copyright,
4 and was granted the exclusive rights in and to the copyrighted design and/or fabric
5 titled “MA 0606111,” and received a Certificate of Registration from the Register
6 of Copyrights bearing registration number VAu-712-212, a copy of which is
7 attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and is incorporated herein by reference.

8 9. Since June, 2006, to the best of MAJOR TEXTILE’s knowledge, said
9 fabric design and/or pattern has been only published by MAJOR TEXTILE, and all
10 copies of same have been printed, reproduced and published in strict conformity
11 with the provisions of the Copyright Act, and all other laws governing copyright.

12 10. At all times since June 2006, MAJOR TEXTILE has been and still is
13 the sole proprietor of all right, title and interest in and to the copyright of said
14 fabric design and/or pattern, and MAJOR TEXTILE is the sole proprietor thereof.

15 11. At all times since June 2006, MAJOR TEXTILE has been and still is
16 the sole rightful manufacturer of fabric or any goods bearing the aforementioned
17 copyrighted design and/or pattern, and has had, and still has, the exclusive right to
18 sell any such fabric or other goods.

19 12. That pursuant to such sole and exclusive rights, MAJOR TEXTILE
20 after June 2006, commenced and did thereafter manufacture fabric bearing
21 imprints of the said copyrighted design and/or pattern, and has shown, sampled,
22 offered for sale and sold such fabric to manufacturers and/or retailers of garments.

23 13. A sample of MAJOR TEXTILE’s copyrighted design and/or pattern is
24 attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and is incorporated herein by this reference.

COUNT 1 - COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT

1
2 14. Since at least as early as and prior to June 2007, ALL ACCESS,
3 which is, upon information and belief, a business that manufactures and sells
4 apparel and accessories on a nationwide basis to national retailers under the trade
5 name and/or trademark SELF ESTEEM, has on a nationwide basis, infringed said
6 copyright by manufacturing or causing to be manufactured, offering for sale and
7 selling within the United States, without MAJOR TEXTILE's consent, garments
8 imprinted with a design and/or pattern which is closely copied from and
9 substantially similar to MAJOR TEXTILE's copyrighted design, pattern and/or
10 fabric entitled MA 0606111.

11 15. Since at least as early as June 2007, ALL ACCESS infringed said
12 copyright by offering for sale and selling within the United States, without
13 MAJOR TEXTILE's consent, garments imprinted with a design and/or pattern
14 which is closely copied from and substantially similar to MAJOR TEXTILE's
15 copyrighted design, pattern and/or fabric entitled MA 0606111. Attached hereto as
16 Exhibit 4 and incorporated herein by this reference is a true and correct copy of an
17 infringing garment manufactured by ALL ACCESS and purchased from Ross
18 Department Stores on or about June 2007 that infringed on MAJOR TEXTILE's
19 copyrighted design and/or pattern identified as MA 0606111.

20 16. MAJOR TEXTILE has gone to great expense in designing,
21 developing, purchasing and marketing its intellectual property including the design
22 and/or pattern identified as MA 0606111 and as contained within the designs
23 comprising U.S. Copyright Registration No. VAu-712-212.

24 17. MAJOR TEXTILE has always printed its copyrighted design on good
25 quality fabric in attractive color combinations and has sold fabric bearing the
26 copyrighted design to garment manufacturers and others.

27 ///

1 18. As a result of MAJOR TEXTILE's skill, expenditure of money and
2 expertise in the development and promotion of the copyrighted design and/or
3 fabric, MAJOR TEXTILE's garments imprinted with said design have acquired
4 substantial market value.

5 19. The design and/or pattern known and registered as MA 0606111 was
6 one of MAJOR TEXTILE'S most successful designs in years as large quantities of
7 fabric imprinted with said design and/or pattern were ordered from MAJOR
8 TEXTILE by its customers.

9 20. The infringing garment purchased on or about June 2007 is imprinted
10 with a pattern substantially similar to the copyrighted design, on a fabric which is
11 similar to, but of lesser weight and quality, than the fabric sold by MAJOR
12 TEXTILE which is imprinted with the copyrighted design and/or pattern.

13 21. The infringing design by ALL ACCESS is copied from and
14 substantially similar to MAJOR TEXTILE's design (see Exhibit 3) identified and
15 federally registered as MA 0606111.

16 22. Defendants, by virtue of the aforesaid acts, have taken advantage of
17 the knowledge, skill and good will developed by MAJOR TEXTILE in the
18 copyrighted design and have capitalized upon the market created by MAJOR
19 TEXTILE for their copyrighted design.

20 23. By their use of a design and color combinations substantially similar
21 to MAJOR TEXTILE's design and color and combinations, ALL ACCESS has
22 been able to pass off and sell their garments as a substitute for garments made from
23 MAJOR TEXTILE's fabric bearing the copyrighted design.

24 24. The aforesaid acts of Defendants in manufacturing, causing to be
25 manufactured, importing, marketing, advertising, converting, printing, selling,
26 and/or offering for sale garments imprinted with a design and/or pattern in virtually
27 identical color combinations as copied from MAJOR TEXTILE's copyrighted
28 design, constitute infringement, inequitable conduct, unfair trade practices and

1 unfair competition in that Defendants have thereby misappropriated MAJOR
2 TEXTILE's good will and the benefits of MAJOR TEXTILE's skill and
3 expenditures in the development and promotion of the distinctive designs and by
4 reason thereof has caused irreparable injury to MAJOR TEXTILE in that MAJOR
5 TEXTILE's market has been greatly reduced thereby, which injury will continue
6 as long as Defendants continue to market garments made from fabric imprinted
7 with the copyrighted design.

8 **WHEREFORE, MAJOR TEXTILE** demands as follows:

9 1. That Defendants and their agents and servants be enjoined during the
10 pendency of this action and permanently from infringing Copyright No. VAu-712-
11 212 of MAJOR TEXTILE, covering the aforementioned copyrighted design, in
12 any manner and from manufacturing, converting, promoting, importing, selling,
13 marketing or otherwise disposing of any garments imprinted with a design
14 copyrighted from MAJOR TEXTILE's said design and/or fabric.

15 2. That Defendants be required to pay MAJOR TEXTILE such damages
16 which MAJOR TEXTILE has sustained in consequence of Defendants'
17 infringement of said copyright and to account for all gains, profits and advantages
18 derived by Defendants by its infringement of MAJOR TEXTILE's copyright and
19 such damages as to the Court shall appear proper within the provisions of the
20 copyright statute.

21 3. That Defendants be required to deliver up to be impounded during the
22 pendency of this action all garments made from fabric imprinted with a copy of
23 said design and/or fabric in their possession or under their control and to deliver up
24 for destruction all infringing copies and all plates, molds, and other matter for
25 making such infringing copies.

26 4. That Defendants pay to MAJOR TEXTILE the costs of this action and
27 reasonable attorney's fees to be allowed to MAJOR TEXTILE by the Court.

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5. That MAJOR TEXTILE have such other and further relief as is just and proper.
