### JURISDICTION AND VENUE

- 1. This action arises under the Copyright Act of 1976, Title 17 U.S.C., § 101 et seq.
- 2. This Court has federal question jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. § 1331 and 1338 (a) and (b).
- 3. Venue in this judicial district is proper under 28 U.S.C. § 1391(c) and 1400(a) in that this is the judicial district in which a substantial part of the acts and omissions giving rise to the claims occurred.

#### **PARTIES**

- 4. Plaintiff L.A. PRINTEX INDUSTRIES, INC. ("LAP") is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of California with its principal place of business located at 3270 East 26<sup>th</sup> Street, Vernon, California 90023.
- 5. Plaintiff is informed and believes and thereon alleges that Defendant CHARLOTTE RUSSE, INC. ("CHARLOTTE") is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of California and doing business in and with the State of California.
- 6. Plaintiff is informed and believes and thereon alleges that some of Defendants DOES 1 through 3, inclusive, are manufacturers and/or vendors of garments to Defendant, which DOE Defendants have manufactured and/or supplied and are manufacturing and/or supplying garments comprised of fabric printed with Plaintiff's copyrighted Design Nos. C30114, D40354 and D40403 (as hereinafter defined) without Plaintiff's knowledge or consent or have contributed to said infringement. The true names, whether corporate, individual or otherwise of Defendants DOES 1-3, inclusive, are presently unknown to Plaintiff, which therefore sues said Defendants by such fictitious names and will seek leave to amend this complaint to show their true names and capacities when same have been ascertained.

- 7. Defendants DOES 4 through 10, inclusive, are other parties not yet identified who have infringed Plaintiff's copyrights, have contributed to the infringement of Plaintiff's copyrights, or have engaged in one or more of the wrongful practices alleged herein. The true names, whether corporate, individual or otherwise, of Defendants 4 through 10, inclusive, are presently unknown to Plaintiff, which therefore sues said Defendants by such fictitious names, and will seek leave to amend this Complaint to show their true names and capacities when same have been ascertained.
- 8. Plaintiff is informed and believes and thereon alleges that at all times relevant hereto each of the Defendants was the agent, affiliate, officer, director, manager, principal, alter-ego, and/or employee of the remaining Defendants and was at all times acting within the scope of such agency, affiliation, alter-ego relationship and/or employment; and actively participated in or subsequently ratified and adopted, or both, each and all of the acts or conduct alleged, with full knowledge of all the facts and circumstances, including, but not limited to, full knowledge of each and every violation of Plaintiff's rights and the damages to Plaintiff proximately caused thereby.

### CLAIMS RELATED TO DESIGN NO. C30114

- 9. Prior to the conduct complained of herein, Plaintiff composed an original two-dimensional artwork for purposes of textile printing. It allocated this design Plaintiff's Internal Design Number C30114 ("Subject Design"). A true and correct image of the Subject Design has been attached hereto as Exhibit One.
- 10.Plaintiff applied for and received copyright registration for the Subject Design on September 23, 2005, with the Subject Design being granted the assignment of Registration No. VA 1-334-155. A copy of said registration is attached hereto as Exhibit Two.

- 11. Prior to the acts complained of herein, Plaintiff sampled and sold fabric bearing the Subject Design to numerous parties in the fashion and apparel industries.
- 12. Following this distribution of product bearing the Subject Design,
  Plaintiff's investigation revealed that certain entities within the fashion and apparel
  industries had misappropriated the Subject Design, and were selling fabric and
  garments bearing illegal reproductions and derivations of the Subject Design.

#### **CLAIMS RELATED TO DESIGN NO. D40354**

- 13. Prior to the conduct complained of herein, Plaintiff composed an original two-dimensional artwork for purposes of textile printing. It allocated this design Plaintiff's Internal Design Number D40354 ("Subject Design"). A true and correct image of the Subject Design has been attached hereto as Exhibit Three.
- 14.Plaintiff applied for and received copyright registration for the Subject Design on July 20, 2006, with the Subject Design being granted the assignment of Registration No. VA 1-380-034. A copy of said registration is attached hereto as Exhibit Four.
- 15. Prior to the acts complained of herein, Plaintiff sampled and sold fabric bearing the Subject Design to numerous parties in the fashion and apparel industries.
- 16. Following this distribution of product bearing the Subject Design, Plaintiff's investigation revealed that certain entities within the fashion and apparel industries had misappropriated the Subject Design, and were selling fabric and garments bearing illegal reproductions and derivations of the Subject Design.

### **CLAIMS RELATED TO DESIGN NO. D40403**

17. Prior to the conduct complained of herein, Plaintiff composed an original two-dimensional artwork for purposes of textile printing. It allocated this design

Plaintiff's Internal Design Number D40403 ("Subject Design"). A true and correct image of the Subject Design has been attached hereto as Exhibit Five.

- 18. Plaintiff applied for and received copyright registration for the Subject Design on December 29, 2006, with the Subject Design being granted the assignment of Registration No. VA 1-394-211. A copy of said registration is attached hereto as Exhibit Six.
- 19. Prior to the acts complained of herein, Plaintiff sampled and sold fabric bearing the Subject Design to numerous parties in the fashion and apparel industries. Following this distribution of product bearing the Subject Design, Plaintiff's investigation revealed that certain entities within the fashion and apparel industries had misappropriated the Subject Design, and were selling fabric and garments bearing illegal reproductions and derivations of the Subject Design.
- 20. The CHARLOTTE Garments: Plaintiff is informed and believes and thereon alleges that, without Plaintiff's authorization, CHARLOTTE, created, manufactured, caused to be manufactured, imported, distributed, and/or sold fabric and/or garments comprised of fabric featuring a design which is identical, or substantially similar, to the Subject Design. (hereinafter "CHARLOTTE Garment(s)").
- 21. Plaintiff is informed and believes and thereon alleges that the CHARLOTTE Garments were created by one of the DOE 1-10 defendants, and sold through CHARLOTTE retail outlets, catalogues and on-line stores. One exemplar of a CHARLOTTE Garment is attached hereto as Exhibit Seven.
- 22. The CHARLOTTE Garments will be collectively referred to as "Subject Garments."
- 23. Plaintiff's investigators located and purchased Subject Garments at the retail stores of various Defendants. These sales by Defendants, and each of them, of

27 28 said garments constituted an infringement of Plaintiff's exclusive rights under 17 U.S.C. 106 et seq.

24. Plaintiff issued cease and desist letters to Defendants, and each of them, and is informed and believes and thereon alleges that, in spite of their receipt of the aforementioned cease and desist demand letters, Defendants, and each of them, continued to sell Subject Garments in violation of Plaintiff's rights as the copyright proprietor and owner of the Subject Designs.

#### FIRST CLAIM FOR RELIEF

(For Copyright Infringement - Against All Defendants, and Each)

25. Plaintiff repeats, realleges and incorporates herein by reference as though fully set forth the allegations contained in Paragraphs 1 through 24, inclusive, of this Complaint.

26. Plaintiff is informed and believes and thereon alleges that Defendants, and each of them, had access to the Subject Design, including, without limitation, through (a) access to Plaintiff's showroom and/or design library; (b) access to illegally distributed copies of the Subject Design by third-party vendors and/or DOE Defendants, including without limitation international and/or overseas converters and printing mills; and (c) access to Plaintiff's strike-offs and samples.

27. Plaintiff is informed and believes and thereon alleges that one or more of the Defendants manufactures garments and/or is a garment vendor. Plaintiff is further informed and believes and thereon alleges that said Defendant(s), and each of them, has an ongoing business relationship with Defendant retailers, and each of them, and supplied garments to said retailers, which garments infringed the Subject Design in that said garments were composed of fabric which featured unauthorized print designs that were identical or substantially similar to the Subject Design, or were an illegal modification thereof.

Plaintiff is informed and believes and thereon alleges that Defendants, and each of them, infringed Plaintiff's copyright by creating, making and/or developing directly infringing and/or derivative works from the Subject Design and by producing, distributing and/or selling Subject Garments through a nationwide network of retail stores, catalogues, and through on-line websites.

- 29. Due to Defendants' acts of infringement, Plaintiff has suffered substantial damages to its business in an amount to be established at trial.
- 30. Due to Defendants' acts of infringement, Plaintiff has suffered general and special damages in an amount to be established at trial.
- 31. Due to Defendants' acts of copyright infringement as alleged herein, Defendants, and each of them, have obtained direct and indirect profits they would not otherwise have realized but for their infringement of the Subject Design. As such, Plaintiff is entitled to disgorgement of Defendant's profits directly and indirectly attributable to Defendant's infringement of the Subject Design in an amount to be established at trial.
- 32. Plaintiff is informed and believes and thereon alleges that Defendants, and each of them, have continued to import, manufacture, cause to be manufactured and/or sell Subject Garments after Plaintiff demanded that they cease and desist from engaging in same. Therefore, Defendants' acts of copyright infringement as alleged above were, and continue to be, willful, intentional and malicious, subjecting Defendants, and each of them, to liability for statutory damages under Section 504(c)(2) of the Copyright Act in the sum of up to one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) per infringement. Further, Defendants', and each of their, willful and intentional misappropriation and/or infringement of Plaintiff's copyrighted Subject Design renders Defendants, and each of them, liable for statutory damages as described herein. Within the time permitted by law, Plaintiff will make its election between actual damages and statutory damages.

SECOND CLAIM FOR RELIEF

(For Vicarious and/or Contributory Copyright Infringement - Against All

33. Plaintiff repeats, realleges and incorporates herein by reference as though fully set forth the allegations contained in Paragraphs 1 through 32, inclusive, of this Complaint.

34.Plaintiff is informed and believes and thereon alleges that Defendants knowingly induced, participated in, aided and abetted in and profited from the illegal reproduction and/or subsequent sales of garments featuring the Subject Design as alleged herein.

35. Plaintiff is informed and believes and thereon alleges that Defendants, and each of them, are vicariously liable for the infringement alleged herein because they had the right and ability to supervise the infringing conduct and because they had a direct financial interest in the infringing conduct.

36. By reason of the Defendants', and each of their, acts of copyright infringement as alleged above, Plaintiff has suffered and will continue to suffer substantial damages to its business in an amount to be established at trial, as well as additional general and special damages in an amount to be established at trial.

37. Due to Defendants', and each of their acts of copyright infringement as alleged herein, Defendants, and each of them, have obtained direct and indirect profits they would not otherwise have realized but for their infringement of the Subject Design. As such, Plaintiff is entitled to disgorgement of Defendants' profits directly and indirectly attributable to Defendants' infringement of the Subject Design, in an amount to be established at trial.

38. Plaintiff is informed and believes and thereon alleges that Defendants, and each of them, have continued to manufacture and/or sell Subject Garments after

Plaintiff demanded that they cease and desist from engaging in same. Therefore, Defendants' acts of copyright infringement as alleged above were, and continue to be, willful, intentional and malicious, subjecting Defendants, and each of them, to liability therefore, including statutory damages under Section 504(c)(2) of the Copyright Act in the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) per infringement. Further, Defendants', and each of their, willful and intentional misappropriation and/or infringement of Plaintiff's copyrighted Subject Design renders Defendants, and each of them, liable for statutory damages as described herein. Within the time permitted by law, Plaintiff will make its election between actual damages and statutory damages.

#### PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Wherefore, Plaintiff prays for judgment as follows:

# Against All Defendants

### With Respect to Each Claim for Relief

- a. That Defendants, their agents and servants be enjoined from importing, manufacturing, distributing, offering for sale, selling or otherwise trafficking in any product that infringes Plaintiff's copyrights in the Subject Design;
- b. That Plaintiff be awarded all profits of Defendants plus all losses of Plaintiff, the exact sum to be proven at the time of trial, or, if elected before final judgment, statutory damages as available under the Copyright Act, 17 U.S.C. § 101 et seq.;
- c. That Plaintiff be awarded its attorneys' fees as available under the Copyright Act U.S.C. § 101 et seq.;
- d. That Defendants, and each of them, account to Plaintiff for their profits and any damages sustained by Plaintiff arising from the foregoing acts of infringement;




