## **JURISDICTION AND PARTIES**

- (c) That defendant be required to pay plaintiff such damages as plaintiff has sustained as a consequence of its infringement of plaintiff copyrighted design, and to account for all gains, profits, and advantages derived by it from its infringement, including profits on all sales of fabrics, bandannas and goods embodying any copy of the copyrighted designs, pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 504.
- (d) That defendant be required to pay to plaintiff the costs of this action pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 505.
- (e) That plaintiff have such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and appropriate.
